### AFFIDAVIT OF RHONDA ANDERSON

- 1. I hereby affirm and declare under the penalties of perjury that the following is true and correct based on my personal knowledge.
- 2. My name is Rhonda Anderson, and I am over the age of eighteen and competent to testify in the courts of this State.
- 3. I have been Supervisor, Customer Service for the Maryland State Board of Physicians since June, 2014.
- 4. On Friday, December 11, 2020, I received a call from the building receptionist at the Board's offices who said someone from Courthouse Copiers was in the lobby with items to deliver to the Board and someone needed to come down to the lobby to retrieve the items. I asked how many boxes were being dropped, and she replied no boxes, only paperwork.
- 5. After the call, I went downstairs to the building's lobby to meet with the individual I thought was from Courthouse Copiers. As I approached the gentleman in the lobby, I called out loud, "Courthouse Copiers?" I don't recall hearing a reply from him but he proceeded to hand me a set of documents consisting of three (3) pages. Exhibit A, attached hereto. He said something that I didn't understand (he was wearing a mask). I thought he said "I know who you are" in reference to my name while handling his phone. Thinking he was mistaking me for another Board employee, I stated we never met and proceeded to give him my name which he typed into his phone.
- 6. When I returned upstairs and I carefully reviewed the three pages handed to me (Exhibit A), I became concerned that he may not have been a courier from Courthouse Copiers but someone delivering a summons to the Board. I then notified Dr. Yemisi Koya, my supervisor, who said I should date stamp a copy of the three pages and return the original and date stamped copies to her.
- 7. I am not authorized by law to accept service of process on behalf of the Board of Physicians.
