

# What to do if I got scammed on Trust Wallet? Scammed on Trust Wallet? Act Now

If [US] 1—866—240—0437 [US] you got scammed on Trust Wallet, act quickly. While transactions can't be reversed, you should report the scam to Trust Wallet [US] 1—866—240—0437 [US] support, block the scammer's address, and report the incident to local authorities or a cybercrime unit.
