1-833_534_0992 If you are looking for the quickest way to stop your AVG automatic subscription, call 1-833_534_0992 and have your account details ready. Automatic renewals are enabled by default for most AVG products, so it's important to act before your next billing date to avoid unwanted charges. Make sure you have your registered email, order number, and the last four digits of the payment card used on file.
